The nation's largest gay rights magazine has ranked *Spokane* as the third (3rd) gayest city in the nation. Two other Washington cities made the top five, including Seattle at No. 5 and Tacoma leading the way as the gayest city in the nation.

The news of a No. 3 ranking came as a happy surprise to Marvo Reguindin, general manager of the Inland Northwest Business Alliance, the chamber of commerce for gay businesses and those allied with them.
