The world's most active volcano explore has been in a constant state of eruption since January 2008. It's less than a mile away. Depending on changing volcanic activity, you may have an opportunity to view an active lava flow from either within the park or from a viewing area outside the park operated by Hawaii County. You'll want to start your visit at the Kilauea Visitor Center, at the 4000 foot elevation where you can obtain information on current lava conditions. From there you can drive to the Steam Vents, the Thurston Lava Tube, Hawaiian Volcano Observatory and Jaggar Museum and drive down Chain of Craters Road Resulted to

stop by the excellent Volcano Art Center.
